## A need arose

The five founding organisations of the Civil Society Information Centre Namibia (CIVIC +264) agreed that such an information service would advance the effectiveness of civil society in Namibia.



Thus CIVIC +264 was established in 2019 with the aim to facilitate the circulation of information in the civil society community and an initial database of civil society organisations was compiled, which is continuously updated and extended.

The Civil Society Information Centre Namibia as well as its website were officially launched on Tuesday, 10th November 2020.

## What we do

CIVIC +264 was established as an information sharing service for Namibian civil society.



### Objectives

- To act as a conduit for information relevant to civil society in Namibia.
- to develop and maintain a database of active Namibian civil society organisations.
- to monitor and share developments in civil society, government and the donor community which are relevant to civil society in Namibia.
- to facilitate networking opportunities amongst civil society and between civil society and other relevant stakeholders.
- to connect civil society organisations with government bodies and donors in connection with specific issues, in light of the areas of interest of various civil society organisations; and
- to create and maintain a website and a presence on appropriate social media platforms with the aim of enhancing communication to and between civil society organisations.
