**SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR INPUTS ON THE DRAFT NATIONAL MONITORING AND EVALUATION
POLICY AND THE IMPLEMENTATION PLAN**

The National Planning Commission (NPC) derives its mandate from article 129 of the constitution and the NPC Act of 2013 (Act No. 2 of 2013). As per this mandate, amongst others, NPC is entrusted with the responsibility of developing Monitoring and Evaluation (M&E) mechanisms. In accordance with this mandate, the National Planning Commission with financial and technical support from UNICEF Namibia and the Centre for Learning on Evaluation and Results-Anglophone Africa (CLEAR-AA) respectively, has developed a National Monitoring and Evaluation Policy (NM&E) and its accompanying Implementation Plan (IP) as per existing Policy Development Guidelines.

Furthermore, the policy promotes the use of M&E thereof, to improve decision- and policy-making, budgeting, accountability and transparency. The development of this draft policy involved various stakeholders from OMAs, Regional councils, and Local Authorities, in collaboration with UNICEF and (CLEAR-AA).
